



PCC/Mission Community Stewardship Planning Session

This is often an excellent place to start. The session creates a productive and creative opportunity to review the current state of play with regards to stewardship and the management of resources. By using popular managerial analysis techniques, church officials are encouraged to talk to each other about possible strategies to promote sacrificial giving within their communities. This reflective session gives scope to plan ahead and access continued support.

Giving in Grace

Since 2005, Giving in Grace has been used extensively in a range of churches and traditions. With careful and prayerful planning, this fully resourced stewardship programme, now revised and simplified, will yield financial resources for mission and help build a culture of generous discipleship. Six Steps of Christian Giving

A one-hour workshop which focuses on our call to discipleship and the responsibility to give sacrificially in all areas of our lives. Includes activities, Bible study clips and a prayer aid to take home.



Address during a Service

Using the lectionary reading as a starting point, I can come and talk to the congregation about sacrificial giving. This is very popular and needs to be booked in advance to avoid disappointment. I have experience in preaching in a variety of churches and can adapt my presentation style accordingly. I would recommend booking a Six Steps of Christian Giving workshop to follow the service. Congregation members can then choose to attend based upon what they have heard.

Co-ordinated Rollout of Parish Giving Scheme

PGS presentations can be delivered during PCC meetings or services. Publicity is provided, and a bespoke rollout plan can be discussed and created.
