

Fairtrade Fortnight in Devon 2018

Fairtrade tea growers Victor Biwot and Esther Chepkwony are visiting Devon for Fairtrade Fortnight and have a busy schedule of visits to schools and community events in ten towns across Devon and Plymouth, organised by Fairtrade Devon.

They were in Chudleigh on Monday 26 February in Brixham on Tuesday 27 February, at the Lord Mayor's Tea Party in Exeter on Wed 27 Feb, at All Saints Church Hall Sidmouth for a 'Meet the Fairtrade Tea Farmers' at 1:30 pm with Fairtrade stalls and refreshments, then in Plymouth with Bishop Nick, 7.30pm St Jude's Church Hall, for a presentation and Fairtrade stalls and competitions.

They are meeting people for breakfast 8-10.30am on Friday 2 March at Fair's Fair Shop in Bear Street, Barnstaple, and then visitng Teignmouth for the afternoon and evening. On Saturday 3 March they are at the Exeter Fairtrade Street Fair and visiting Buckfast Abbey on Sunday 4 March. On Monday 5 March Esther Chepkwony is taking tea at 3.30pm in Fairplace Church, Okehampton. They are visiting schools and colleges in Exmouth on Tuesday 6 March where Holy Trinity, a Fairtrade Church, serves Fairtrade refreshments during week-day mornings in Rolle Road. On Wednesday 7 March they visit Exeter University, a Fairtrade University, and visit Totnes on Thursday 8 March and finally Dawlish on Friday 9 March.
