At time of going to press, there doesn't seem to be a consensus about the date. Last year, there were 5,145 cases reported in the UK – the highest on record – and 41% involved children under 18. There are resources to help raise awareness of modern slavery and equip the local church and community to get involved. For help and advice call any time on 0800 0121 700. If you think slavery is happening, do not attempt to let the victim know that you have reported it or confront the traffickers. You need to ensure their safety and yours.
