

Online Checklist

Our buildings may be closed, but our churches are still reaching out in new ways. Here is a simple checklist so you can ensure your church website clearly shows your church is still open for business online:

- Have a link from your website homepage and social media pages to any livestreamed or recorded services at your church. Include an order of service where possible. You can also link to the Diocese services: <https://exeter.anglican.org/resources/coronavirus-guidance/sunday-services-to-watch-online/>
- Have a contact telephone number on your home page so people don't have to hunt for it.
- Have you got a church Facebook page (or other social media)? If yes, is all the contact information and content up to date?
- Have you the correct Safeguarding information / links on your website, and are there links regarding support for those suffering from domestic violence? www.exeter.anglican.org/resources/safeguarding.
- Have you checked your 'A Church Near You' entry, to make sure that the contact information and links are correct? www.achurchnearyou.com
- Is there information on your home page about practical support during the lockdown? (Either information about what the church is offering or a link to a local Covid Response group).
- Is there information for people enquiring about funerals, weddings or baptisms?
- Is there a way people can email prayer requests or leave a message asking for prayer?
- Are you signposting families to activities for children? Such as www.diddydisciples.org.
- Is there information on your home page about how people can sign-up for a weekly email newsletter, online parish magazine or weekly phone call?
