

HOW TO
PLAY

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Instructions

Before playing you will need pen, paper, timer, and a group of friends.

1. Separate the cards into categories: action (purple) and questions (green). You can include your own questions on the blank green cards. There is an artist and a group of spectators.
2. Decide the order of play. The artist draws a card from both categories and makes these visible to the spectators.
3. The artist responds to the question card by either drawing or acting this out (based on the chosen action card).
4. **For drawing**, the artist is given a piece of paper and a pencil and draws their response to the revealed card. Their response must also be written down and remain unrevealed until a spectator has guessed the answer (or time has ended). The countdown of 1 minute starts as soon as the drawing begins. The written answer will function as quality control.
5. **For acting**, the artist acts out their response to the revealed card. This must also be written down and remain unrevealed until a spectator has guessed the answer (or time has ended). The countdown of 1 minute starts as soon as the acting begins. The written answer will function as quality control.
6. The spectator who guesses correctly will get a point along with the artist who responded to the question.
7. This then continues until a set limit is reached.

Example

- Question card "What would you do to make somebody happy?"
- Say the action card is Act, the player will act out their response to the card, such as giving a hug.
- The rest of the players will guess aiming to reach the answer 'giving a hug'
