



APRIL PRAYER DIARY

Reflecting on the words of Romans 5:9, we pray:

Lord, as we journey into Easter, we remember that you demonstrated the greatest unconditional love to us by sending your son to be crucified. We give thanks for the incredible sacrifice that you made, and that you broke the chains of our sin and shame so that we can live in freedom. Help us to live in a way that glorifies you and help us to share your love with those we meet.

We encourage you to reflect on this passage throughout this month and use it to guide your prayer time.

Wednesday 1st – Saturday 4th

During Holy Week, we remember your journey to the cross. That you suffered many things, were rejected, betrayed and killed to save us. May we be filled with awe and thanksgiving at what you endured for us and filled with hope that you rose from the dead and conquered the grave.

3. On Good Friday, we remember Jesus' crucifixion. In your innocence, you died for the guilty. "God shows his love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

4. On Holy Saturday, we reflect on the significance of the cross. On a day that was silent with the unknown of what would happen next, we reflect on all that Jesus endured on the cross to pay the price for our sins, and we hold fast to the hope of his resurrection.

Sunday 5th – Saturday 11th

During the Easter school holidays, we pray that teachers, staff and pupils would find rest. We pray and give thanks for churches planning holiday clubs and activities. Would you give them energy as they serve children and families in our communities.
