



OCTOBER PRAYER DIARY

Reflecting on the words of Galatians 6:9, we pray:

Lord, we thank you that our good deeds are never wasted. We pray that when we feel weary, you would sustain us and renew our strength. Help us to continue to show your love to those we meet, planting seeds of kindness, patience, and hope. We give thanks for the harvest that is coming. Amen.

We encourage you to reflect on this passage throughout this month and use it to guide your prayer time.

Thursday 1st – Saturday 3th

During Black History Month, we give thanks for the diversity of the church, and lament times when Christianity has been misused to divide and oppress. Remind us that all people are made in the image of God and help us to grow together in love and unity.

We give thanks for organisations working to prevent and treat breast cancer. We pray those who are currently fighting this disease would know you are near, God.

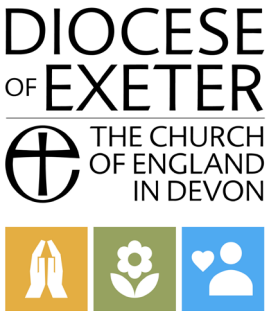
